Evangelisation Parish Cell System: the reason behind the system

The System

The system is composed of a solid structure directed by the Parish Priest. Each level of the structure is dependent and interrelated with its other parts. Through a well organized structure, this system helps in the build-up of the living body which is the Church.

Parish

The Cell System is fully inserted into the fabric of the Parish Community, defined by John Paul II in *Christifideles Laici* as the "Community of faith and physical community in which the Parish Priest is the organisational link to the whole Church". (n° 26)

The Cell

The cell is the fundamental unit of biology, endowed with life and with the potential to generate new life by the process of multiplication. Likewise, the evangelising Cell is made up of a group of people held together by the bonds of "OIKOS", whose aim is to evangelise and make disciples, for instance, to bring Jesus, the True Life, to others. As it grows in numbers, the Cell multiplies, giving birth to a "daughter" Cell.

Evangelisation

"The Church exists to evangelise" as Paul VI reminds us in *Evangelii Nuntiandi*. In the same way the cell, "the Church in miniature", rediscovers and brings to life this fundamental vocation:

SHARE JESUS WITH OTHERS.

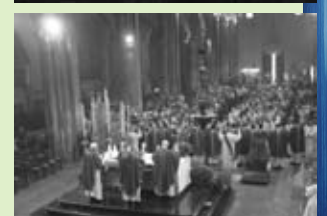
